## PSED

## Maths

- To use objects to solve addition and subtraction problems.
  - To share objects between groups of people equally.
  - To explore number bonds to 5.

## Expressive arts and design

- To use a range of resources to create own props to aid role play.
  - To plan, carry out and evaluate and change where necessary.
- Manipulates materials to achieve a planned effect

## Understanding the world

- To identify and sort healthy/unhealthy foods.
  - To identify and group minibeasrs.
  - To talk about a special event in their life.

## Communication and language

- To describe familiar texts with detail and using full sentences.

## Literacy
