

Supporting your child at home

As you know, we don't set formal homework each week but we do ask that you support us with some learning at home. We feel that it is really important that the children get into good habits with home working as well as giving you an opportunity to see how they are progressing in different areas of the curriculum.

Please note that to protect our children the school gates are locked between the hours of 8.30am and 9.05am and 2.45pm and 3.30pm. If you are travelling to school by car during these times, please be aware that you could be locked in the school car park. Please find alternative parking outside the school gates, if required.









Regular Reading. Your child will have a reading book that they bring home each day in their reading folder. We ask that the children or you make at least 3 entries into their reading records so that we can track how they are getting on. They can also go on Reading Plus at home. **Regular Times Tables Practise** Children in year 4 will be taking part in the national multiplication check and therefore it is important that they practise their tables as much as possible. For the children in year 3, it is great for them to get a head start and practice both TT Rockstars in school and at home. **Learning Spellings** Each child will be set 10 spelling from the weekly spelling lists for year 3 and 4, which will be given in the yellow spelling books, which the children keep in their reading folders. You can practise them for the weekly test in any way that is helpful. LBQ Learning Throughout the term, staff will begin setting some optional home learning related to content that they are studying in school. You can find by Questions their LBQ log in inside their reading records. If you are unsure-please just ask your child's teacher.
