Joseph Terry - Joseph Terry was born in 1928 in York. His father was the co-founder of 'Terry's Chocolate' and opened a factory known as 'Terry's Chocolate Works'. Their products included 'Terry's All Gold' and the famous 'Chocolate Orange'. Following his father's death, Joseph Terry and his brothers took over the company. They used steamboats on the River Ouse to move their products around the country!
